All judging decisions are final. Judging will be based on execution of the theme, originality of design and spectator appeal. Awards will be presented 30 minutes after the parade ends at the Gazebo at Mill and Santa Barbara Streets, in the following categories: First and Second Place in all categories, plus Sweepstakes “Best Overall Use of Theme”. 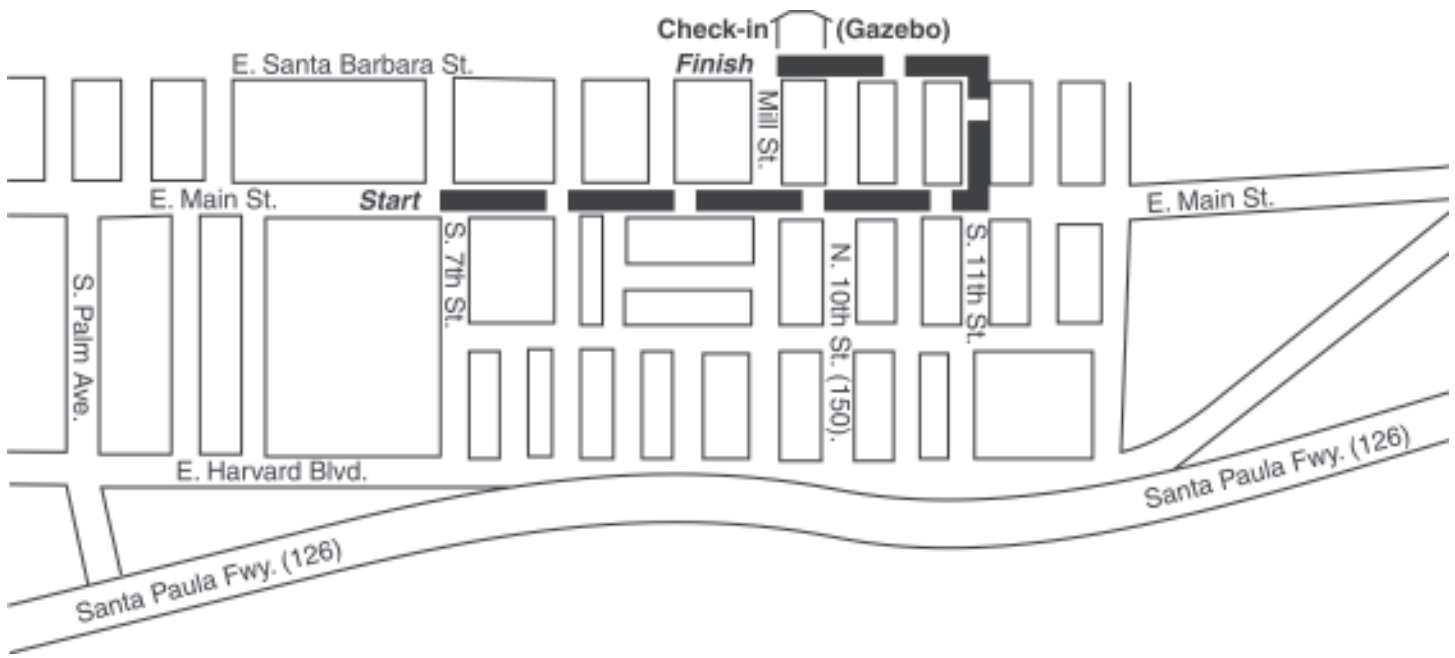
